

Additionally, Metro is working to make the transit hub easier to use for the 75,000 people who pass through the station every day. Part of the master plan also involves widening the tunnel that leads pedestrians to the Metrolink and Amtrak rail lines, which is jammed with harried passengers during rush hour.
